

At the outset, the Joint Secretary (Horticulture)/Managing Director of National Horticulture Board, as Chairman of the Project Appraisal Committee (PAC), extended a warm welcome to all members of the Committee, as well as officials from the Ministry of Agriculture and the National Horticulture Board. He apprised the Committee of the criteria to assess the completeness and compliance of the applications received from all applicants with the prescribed guidelines under the Cluster Development Programme (CDP). He emphasized that the evaluation of each project had already been undertaken by the CDP cell.

Shri Pawan Kumar, Deputy Director (NHB), informed the Committee that the proposals had been evaluated on the basis of the criteria laid down in the CDP guidelines. He guided the members through each applicant's proposal in a structured manner, highlighting key features, compliance status, and gaps observed during the appraisal process.

In consideration of the agenda of the meeting, the following 32 projects along with the Concept Notes were duly discussed by the Project Appraisal Committee, and the following observations were made for each.

M/s Sahyadri Farms Post Harvest Care Limited - 7 applications

The proposal was discussed in detail and it was observed by the committee that the applicant has submitted 7 applications under the 3rd EOI to set up a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster. Details of cluster focus crop and other crops are mentioned below;

- 1. Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with citrus varieties as the focus crop in Nanded District, Maharashtra vide project code no. 27ACDP000186
- 2. Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with grapes as the focus crop in Vijayapura District, Karnataka vide project code no 29ACDP000183
- 3. Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with grapes as the focus crop in Pune District, Maharashtra vide project code no 27ACDP000184
- 4. Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with grapes as the focus crop in Jalna District, Maharashtra vide project code no 27ACDP000185
- Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with grapes as the focus crop in Nashik District, Maharashtra vide project code no 27ACDP000178
- 6. Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with grapes as the focus crop in Sangli District, Maharashtra vide project code no 27ACDP000181
- 7. Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with banana as the focus crop in Solapur District, Maharashtra vide project code no 27ACDP000182

Further, The applicant M/s Sahyadri Farms Post Harvest Care Limited is a Public Limited Company. The applicant has experience in horticulture value chains, farmer aggregation and post-harvest management. For FY 2024–25, the applicant's turnover is ₹1,43,033 lakh more than total project cost of all 8 projects including pilot cluster and net worth is ₹86,041 lakh.

It was also noted by the committee that the applicant is already the Implementing agency (IA) for Grape cluster in Nasik under CDP 1.0 scheme as pilot cluster. In this light, the turnover and net worth criteria were evaluated for all 8 projects (1 old + 7 in this EOI) jointly. It was decided by the committee that the applicant (IA) shall not exceed maximum assistance INR 100 Cr. as per the scheme guidelines of the CDP



all seven proposals majority of the assistance and components are focused on the farmers. Further, Sahyadri Farms has 18,000+ registered farmers and the FPO has been successfully operating for more than 12 years covering over 252 villages and exporting to 42 countries.

The committee discussed the concept note in detail and observed that the applicant fulfils all legal and financial criteria. All seven proposals were technically evaluated and scored 32.5 out of 50 in each application. It was decided that the proposals may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/ business case. It was noted by the committee that the applicant must provide detailed area distribution of other crops in addition to focus crop.

8. M/s Janta Global Agri Pvt. Ltd. & Shodha Farmers Producer Company (Shivamogga Cluster) 29ACDP000177

The applicants Janta Global Agri (a Private Limited Company) and Shodha Farmers Producer Company (a Farmer Producer Company) jointly form a consortium. Janta Global Agri operates through multiple branch offices in Malappuram (Kerala), Ramanadhapuram (Tamilnadu), Visakhapatnam (Andhrapradesh) and Bangalore (Karnataka). The consortium has experience in black pepper and spice value chains, along with exposure to horticulture-based processing and farmer mobilisation. For FY 2024–25, the combined turnover is ₹4,910.09 lakh and net worth is ₹186.13 lakh. The applicants have submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with black pepper as the focus crop in Shivamogga District, Karnataka.

The committee discussed the proposal and observed that the applicants meet legal and financial requirements. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 40.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case.

9. M/s Godrej Agrovet Limited (Cocoa & Coconut Cluster) 28ACDP000170

The applicant Godrej Agrovet Limited is a Public Limited Company. Godrej Agrovet is a food and agri conglomerate, focused at improving the productivity of Indian farmers by innovating products and services. The applicant has extensive experience in plantation crops, farmer engagement and input supply. For FY 2024–25, the applicant's turnover is ₹7,00,907 lakh and net worth is ₹2,57,334 lakh. The applicant has submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with cocoa as the focus crop and coconut as an additional crop in Eluru, NTR and West Godavari Districts, Andhra Pradesh.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicant fulfils all legal and financial criteria. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 33 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case with a declaration of clean financial record.

10. M/s Haritha Bio Actives (Haritha Bio Actives Cluster) 28ACDP000175

The applicant Haritha Bio Actives is a legally registered entity with experience in spices, value addition and related agri-horticultural activities. Specifically, the company is involved making food/beverages like tamarind products, millets For FY 2024–25, the applicant's turnover is ₹12,395.12 lakh and net worth is ₹1,502.35 lakh. The applicant has submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with turmeric as the focus crop in Alluri Sitarama Raju & Parvathipuram Manyam Districts, Andhra Pradesh.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicant meets all legal and financial criteria. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 33 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case.

11. Consortium of A S Chinnaswamy Raju Community Development Trust & Atria Power Corporation Pvt Ltd (Chittoor Moringa Export Cluster) 28ACDP000172

The applicants form a consortium combining an trust and a Private Limited Company. The applicants have experience in farmer mobilisation, moringa cultivation and allied value-chain activities. For FY 2023–24, the consortium's turnover is ₹1,977 lakh and net worth is ₹15,255 lakh. The applicants have submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with moringa as the focus crop in Chittoor District, Andhra Pradesh.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicants fulfil all legal and financial criteria, though area under secondary crops is comparatively low. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 34.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case.

12. M/s TrustGrow Fertilisers India Pvt Ltd & Six Others (Yadgiri Pomegranate Cluster) - 29ACDP000169

The applicant consortium led by TrustGrow Fertilisers India Pvt Ltd includes seven members, of which three are Companies and four are FPOs/FPCs. The lead applicant has experience in providing various high-quality fertilizers, micronutrients, and biostimulants to farmers, focusing on soil health and crop nutrition. For FY 2024–25, the consortium turnover is ₹6,932 lakh and net worth is ₹5,291 lakh. The applicants have submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with pomegranate as the focus crop in Yadgiri and Raichur Districts, Karnataka.

The committee discussed the concept note in detail and observed that the applicants fulfil the legal and financial criteria. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 35.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case.

13. M/s Associated Tea & Agro Management Services Pvt. Ltd. (Spice Root Infra Cluster) – 18ACDP000165

The applicant Associated Tea & Agro Management Services Pvt Ltd is a Private Limited Company with experience in spice crops, agricultural services and value-chain development. For FY 2024–25, the applicant's turnover is ₹615.24 lakh and net worth is ₹105.76 lakh. The applicant has submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with ginger as the focus crop in Golaghat District, Assam.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicant fulfils legal and financial criteria; however, area under other crops was not provided. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 30.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case.

14. M/s Patanjali Foods Limited (Citrus Cluster Maharashtra) – 27ACDP000164

The applicant Patanjali Foods Limited is a Private Limited Company with extensive experience in FMCG. The company is a leading player in edible oils, soya foods (Nutrela), nutraceuticals, and other fast-moving consumer goods and is focused on wellness, Ayurveda, and sustainability with a vast

portfolio of products including oils, biscuits, honey, spices, and personal care. For FY 2024–25, the applicant's turnover is ₹34,28,940 lakh and net worth is ₹7,82,652 lakh. The applicant has submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with orange as the focus crop in Nagpur, Amravati and Wardha Districts, Maharashtra.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicant meets the legal and financial requirements. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 47 out of 50. Applicant may be advised to indicate clearly, list of other crops, area and interventions under the proposed project. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case.

15. M/s Miracle Mango Cluster Private Limited (Mango Cluster) – 28ACDP000157

The applicant Miracle Mango Cluster Private Limited is a Private Limited Company. For FY 2024–25, the applicant's turnover is ₹13,286.45 lakh and net worth is ₹7,519.01 lakh. The applicant has submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with mango as the focus crop in Vizianagaram District, Andhra Pradesh.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that while the applicant meets legal and financial criteria. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 31.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case. It was noted by the committee that the applicant must provide detailed area distribution of other crops in addition to focus crop.

16. Consortium of BMW Ventures Ltd & Jai Basukinath Traders Pvt Ltd (Potato Cluster Purnia, Bihar) 10ACDP000192

The applicants BMW Ventures Ltd (a Private Limited Company) and Jai Basukinath Traders Pvt Ltd (a Private Limited Company) form a consortium. For FY 2024–25, the consortium's turnover is ₹2,06,433.65 lakh and net worth is ₹27,003.89 lakh. The applicants have submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with potato as the focus crop in Purnia District, Bihar.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicants fulfil the legal and financial criteria. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 41.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/ business case. It was noted by the committee that the applicant must provide detailed area distribution of other crops in addition to focus crop.

17. M/s Aterna Agro Alliance (Haryana Multi Commodity High Value Cluster) - 06ACDP000188

The applicant M/s Aterna Agro Alliance is a partnership firm with relevant experience in horticulture and mushroom cultivation. The applicant has previous experience in fresh and IQF value chains for vegetables and baby corn. For FY 2023–24, the applicant's turnover is ₹4,748 lakh and net worth is ₹900 lakh. The applicant has submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with mushroom as the focus crop across Sonipat, Panipat and Karnal Districts, Haryana.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicant meets all legal and financial criteria. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 35.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case. It was noted that the concept note is too brief and the DPR must be comprehensive and detailed.



18. M/s Iscon Balaji Foods Private Limited (Potato Cluster Gujarat) – 24ACDP000193

The applicant Iscon Balaji Foods Private Limited is a Private Limited Company with experience in potato value chains, processing and contract farming, they are a leading player in processed potato products (like fries, patties, wedges) and dehydrated potato flakes. For FY 2024–25, the applicant's turnover is ₹1,50,190.40 lakh and net worth is ₹56,182.20 lakh. The applicant has submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with potato as the focus crop in Patan, Banaskantha and Sabarkantha Districts, Gujarat.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicant meets all legal and financial criteria. However, secondary crops have not been proposed, and a large proportion of project cost relates only to distribution of potato planting material. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 34.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case.

19. M/s Shine Agri Allied and Marketing Multistate Cooperative Society Limited (Kutch & Banaskantha Cluster) – 24ACDP000190

The applicant is a Multistate Cooperative Society with experience in horticultural production, aggregation and allied marketing activities. For FY 2024–25, the applicant's turnover is ₹49,949.69 lakh and net worth is ₹2,996.19 lakh. The applicant has submitted a concept note proposing a Multi-Commodity High Value Cluster with pomegranate as the focus crop in Kutch and Banaskantha Districts, Gujarat.

The committee discussed the concept note and observed that the applicant fulfils all legal and financial criteria. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 36.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR/business case.
